

Slime Ghost



This Halloween, help your kids create a spooky atmosphere at home and unleash their cute little evil side. **Hobby Ideas** shows you how to do that

MATERIAL REQUIRED:

For slime:

1. Glue
2. Highlighter pen
3. Liquid dish wash
4. Baking soda
5. Boric powder
6. Bowl
7. Spoon
8. Water

For ghost:

1. Glue
2. Card paper
3. Pencil
4. Scissor
5. White balloon
6. Straw
7. Plastic bottle
8. Gateway paper or tracing paper
9. Flash light
10. Blue and violet sketch pen

STEP BY STEP GUIDE:

For making slime, take some glue in a bowl and add two teaspoon of liquid dish wash to it.



For making the glow-in-the-dark solution, take half a cup of water and soak the highlighter refill in it till the water becomes coloured. Add one teaspoon of baking soda and half a teaspoon of boric powder to it. Mix it well.

After mixing it, add the solution to the slime mixture and mix it till it forms into a slime.

Next, cut the top part of the plastic bottle to make a funnel. Attach the balloon on the nozzle of the bottle and pour slime into it.



After pouring slime, insert a straw into the balloon and blow air into it, and tie it properly. Parent's help is advisable.

For making the spooky ghost, draw and cut hands, eyes and teeth from coloured chart paper and stick it on the balloon using glue.

To make the ghost glow in dark, you have to create a UK light. For the UV light, colour two small gateway strips using blue sketch pen and two strips using violet sketch pen. Place them alternately on the flash light and stick it with tape. Switch on the flash light in a dark room with your spooky slime ghost and scare your friends! MB
